



Draught of a tract of land situate in Greenwood Township Perry County Containing Two hundred ninety six acres seventy six perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Originally surveyed August 5th, 1773. In pursuance of an Order granted to Jacob Gardner for 300 a. dated August the 19th, 1766, No. 904. The part included within the yellow lines contains 172 as 67 p. & allowance surveyed the 29th day of March 1797 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Corrod Stigers for 200 a. dated March the 10th 1795.

The part within the red lines was surveyed on a warrant to Charles Wright dated March the 28th, 1808 and contains 109 as 91 p. & allowance. The Triangle marked A was surveyed on a warrant granted to Jacob Humler and transferred to Charles Wright dated the 21st day of September 1831 for 24 a. The above three surveys are all the property of Charles Wright Resurveyed October the 25th, 1831. Pr. Wm. Wilson D.S.
