Report. The part of the above Tract marked A separated from B by a dotted line containing 188 as 52 ps & alce has been included with the blank lined figure C in a survey of 416 as 100 ps survey'd 10 Nov'r 1786 on Warrant to Wm. Anderson dated 24 May, 1753 & held by John Rhea under said title. The part marked B has been survey'd on a warrant to Reuben Gillespie for 300 as dated 30 April, 1785, and confirm'd by Patent to Sarah Hamilton held under said title by Jacob Oyster Esq. Note No evidence appears of the Order to Loughery being ever executed on the land, or of any person claiming under the same.
