



A draft of a tract of land situate in Friend's Cove Colerain township Bedford County containing one hundred & one fourth acres & the usual allowance of Six Ft. Cent for Roads & Go. Surveyed for Oliver Miller the 21st day of December 1783 on order No. 3577 dated the second day of May 1767.

No. 1 represented by the dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for John Friend in pursuance of a warrant dated the 25th day of May 1786. This tract interferes with Oliver Miller tract one hundred & one fourth acres. Oliver Miller sold this land to John Friend who obtained the aforesaid warrant. John Friend devised the same to Stewart from whom it was sold by the Sheriff of Bedford county to Joshua Johnston, who conveyed part to Martin Smith the present owner, the residue owned by Joshua Johnston.

No. 2 represented by the blue coloured lines is a draft of a tract surveyed for Robert More in pursuance of a warrant dated the 19th day of April 1766. This survey interferes with the Oliver Miller tract twenty six acres & one hundred & fifty five perches. Robert More conveyed to John Swift who conveyed to Nicholas Border who conveyed to John Waggoner who conveyed to Martin Smith the present owner.
