



M. Rodgarver not Pat'd

A Draft of A Tract of Land situate on the Waters of Dunning's Creek & on the North Side of the Black Oak Ridge in St. Clair township Bedford County Containing three hundred and thirty nine acres & forty perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads Surveyed for John Morgan on Order No. 1592 dated the 20th day of October 1766.

No. 1 represented by the dotted lines is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for Melchor Rodgarver the 27th day of November 1805 in pursuance of A Warrant dated the 29th day of March 1794 This tract interferes fifty five acres & four perches with the John Morgan tract Melchor Rodgarver devised the same to Philip Varce who conveyed to John Lingenfelter the present owner.
