



The dotted lines and the letters A. B. C. D. E. & F. represent in the above diagram represent the survey made to John Ramsey on the 25th of January 1828, a return whereof is herewith enclosed. It will be seen by the above that the said survey interferes with lands previously surveyed as is respectively inserted in the said drafts. The tract in the name of Charles Campbell is owned and occupied by Hugh McTrillip and the tract in the name of Henry Huntle is owned and occupied by George Wainright.
