



A Draft of A tract of land situate on Plum Run about 1 mile from Fort Littleton in Dublin township Bedford County containing one hundred & thirteen acres and twenty five perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads & so Surveyed for William Ramsey on Order No. 4433 dated the 29th day of September 1767 To Gabriel Heister Esqr. S. G. James O'Connor D.S.

No. 1 represented by the broken lines is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for Robert Ramsey the 18th day of April 1821, by virtue of an Improvement commenced forty years ago This tract interferes one hundred and thirteen acres & twenty five perches with the William Ramsey tract William Ramsey devised the aforesaid tract of one hundred & thirteen acres & 25 perches to his heirs (of whom Robert Ramsey was one) who conveyed the same to Robert Ramsey who claims the same by virtue of the aforesaid Improvement Robert Ramsey is the present owner of the land To Gabriel Heister Esqr.
