



By virtue of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property to me directed bearing date the 26th day of the 8th month 1702 to resurvey unto Shadrach Walley several tracts of land in Newtown in the County of Bucks lying contiguous now in the possession of the said Shadrach. Resurveyed the several tracts ~~here~~ hereafter mentioned (viz) A tract laid out ^{for} 250 acres being his original purchase and a tract laid out for the 5^d quantity to Benjamin Roberts, Beginning at a heap of stones by the Town Corners, being Mary Hayworth's corner, Thence by the 5^d Hayworth's Town Lot E by S 146 perches to a post, Then by the Courtrey Lot from a small Hickery over the road N 35 deg^{1/2} E 484 per. to a Hickery in Robert Bonds line, Then by the 5^d Bonds S 2 deg^{1/2} E 36 1/2 per. to a post, Then E 2 deg^{1/2} N 74 per. to a post, Then by vacant Land S 2 deg^{1/2} E 207 p. to a small black oak, Then east 24 p. to a black oak, Then S.E. by E 2 deg^{1/2} S. 161 per. to a post by a white oak, Then by Thomas Jarmey's line S 30 deg^{1/2} W 11 per. to a black oak, Then S.S. W 60 p. to a black oak, Then S.S.E. 88 per. to a small black oak at Sneed's Corner, Thence by Sneed's line W 4 deg^{1/2} N 528 per. to a black oak, Then S by W 5 per. to a black oak at the ^{corner} of the Town Lot, Then W by N 146 p. to a post by the Corners, Then by the same N by E 56 perches to the beginning, The Lot formerly claimed by William Sneed begins at a post by the corner of the 5^d Shadrach's original purchase, Thence by the same E by S 146 per. to a black oak, Then N by E 5 p. to a black oak, Then by the Courtrey Lot E 4 deg^{1/2} S 528 per. to a small black oak in Thomas Jarmey's line, Then by the same S.S.E. 152 per. to a black oak, Then by John Hought's land W 12 deg^{1/2} S 72 per. to a heap of stones, Then by the 5^d Hought's and Israel Taylor's land W 17 deg^{1/2} N 547 per. to a post at the head of the Town Lot, Then W by N 146 per. to a Tree stump by the 5^d Corners, Then by the same N by E 23 per. to the beginning containing 356 acres; The Tract bought of Israel Taylor begins at a Tree stump by the Corners at Sneed's corner, Thence by the 5^d Sneed's line E by S 146 per. to a post, Then E 17 deg^{1/2} S 351 1/2 per. to a heap of stones at John Hought's corner, Then by the 5^d Hought's land S 17 deg^{1/2} W 109 per. to a post, Then W by S 1 deg^{1/2} S. 61 per. to a black oak in Thomas Musgrave's line, Then by the same N by E 53 per. to a small Hickery, Then W by S 1 deg^{1/2} W 134 per. to a stone, Then by James Yates's land N 46 deg^{1/2} W 188 per. to a white oak, Then N by E 6 per. to a black oak, Then W by N 146 per. to a stone by the Corners, Then by the same N by S 54 per. to the beginning containing 289 acres Resurveyed the 10th and 11th days of the 9th month 1702.
