



Resurvey'd on the 23^d September 1806 (agreeable to the old return made on the Back of the warrant granted by W^m Penn unto Daniel Medlicott for a City lot appurtenant to his purchase of 900 acres of land in Pennsylvania dated the 14th of September 1683.) Unto Samuel Emelin Assignee of the Executrix of the Will of said Medlicott, Beginning at the distance of 330 feet southward from the south side of Vine Street (formerly called Valley Street) on the east side of the Schuylkill Second Street, at the south west corner of a lot formerly laid out to the heirs of Charles Jenkins, in right of John Poyer; Thence eastward by the said lot (parallel to Vine Street) 247 1/2 feet, thence southward by Ground sold by the Supreme Executive Council 48 feet, Thence westward by vacant Ground 247 1/2 feet unto the 5^d Second Street, and thence northward by the east side of the said Street 48 feet to the beginning, As shewn by the above Delimitation.
