



Pursuant to a warrant from the Proprietors Commissioners of Property bearing date the 6<sup>th</sup> day of ye 2<sup>nd</sup> mo. 1702 directed unto me I do certify that I have Resurveyed & laid out the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the same, a certaine tract of land in the County of Philadelphia for Robert Fairman beginning at the Kings Road leading to Frankford at a corner deviding it from the land Edward Rees bought of Robert Turner from there by a line of marked trees and same land north north W. 23 perches to a maple by a small run or branch deviding it from Neales Joanes land called Poore Island from there by the severall courses of the said branch 285<sup>+</sup> perches to a fork of the same there by the severall courses of a smaller branch of the said Run 63 perches to another maple tree marked deviding it from land belonging to ye Society front there by a line of marked trees & same land S. E. by S. 50 perches to Francis Raubs land from there by a line of marked trees & same land W. S. W. 72 perches to the said Branch or run first mentioned there by the same south 22 1/2 degrees west 20 perches to the said Road there by ye same south 65 degrees west 78 perches there S. by S. W. 58 perches there south 72 perches West 54 perches to ye first place of beginning. Containeing and laid out for sixty two acres of land and is according to the bounds above described.
