By virtue of the warrant aforesaid. I have caused to be surveyed on the 17th day of June A. D. 1734 for the use aforesaid a tract of land situate near a branch of Schuylkil River called Anderielea in the County of Philadelphia, Beginning at a post at a corner of Moses Starr's land thence by the same south east one hundred & seventy perches to a post, thence by vacant land south west two hundred perches to a black oak, thence by vacant land north west one hundred & seventy perches to a post, thence by Isaac Starr's land north east two hundred perches to the place of Beginning Containing two hundred acres & the allowance of six acres & Cent for Roads &c. Returned into the Secretarys office the 28th day of February Anno Domini 1734.
