



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries Commissioners to me directed bearing date the 10th day of the first month 170¹/₂ to execute all warrants directed to Phineas Pemberton, and pursuant to a warrant from Edward Penington to Phineas Pemberton dated the 1st of the 2^d month 1702 Resurveyed the 15th day of the 2^d month 1702 unto John Snowden and Peter Worrall, a tract of land in Makefield Township containing 662 acres; John Snowden's part contains 430 acres, Beginning at a white oak by the River Delaware, Thence by his other Tract S 53gr. N. 261p. to a black oak, Then S 71gr. W. 56p. to a black oak, Then N 278 per. to a white oak at Peter Worrall's corner. Then by the said Worrall N. 2gr. W. 117p. to a post in Henry Margerum's line, Then by the said Margerum E 156 per. to a small Hickery, Then E by N 138 per. to a black oak, Then N 53gr. E 190 per. to a British tree by the said River, Then down the same S 50gr. E 54 1/2 per. Then S 45gr. E 54 per. Then S 50gr. E 20 per. to the place of Beginning.

Peter Worrall's part contains 232 acres, Beginning at a white oak at John Snowden's corner. Thence by the said Snowden's other tract W 312 per. to a black oak corner. Then by Richard Hought's land N. 2gr. W 117 per. to a black oak at Henry Margerum's (obl.) corner, Then by the said Margerum E 243 per. to a black oak by a fence, Then N 18 per. to a post, Then E 2gr. N 52 per. to a post, Then S. 18 per. to a post, Then E 16p. to a post, Then by John Snowden S 2gr. E 117 per. to the place of Beginning.
