



Situate in Fairview (late Newbury) township York County Containing one hundred acres four perches & allowance of six Per cent Surveyed Per contract on the 3rd day of November, 1831, on Warrant to James Rankin for 100 as dated 20th September 1762, the whole of it included in a survey of 438 as 112 prs & allowance made on warrant to Joseph Glancey dated 1st August 1793.

The dotted lines representing Glancey's survey (which is supposed to be patented) and the black lines representing the present survey and its location relative to Glancey's survey joining lands late of William Baxter among the River hills owned and occupied by Jacob Fisher, Jacob M. Halderman and Peter Hoffstadt.
