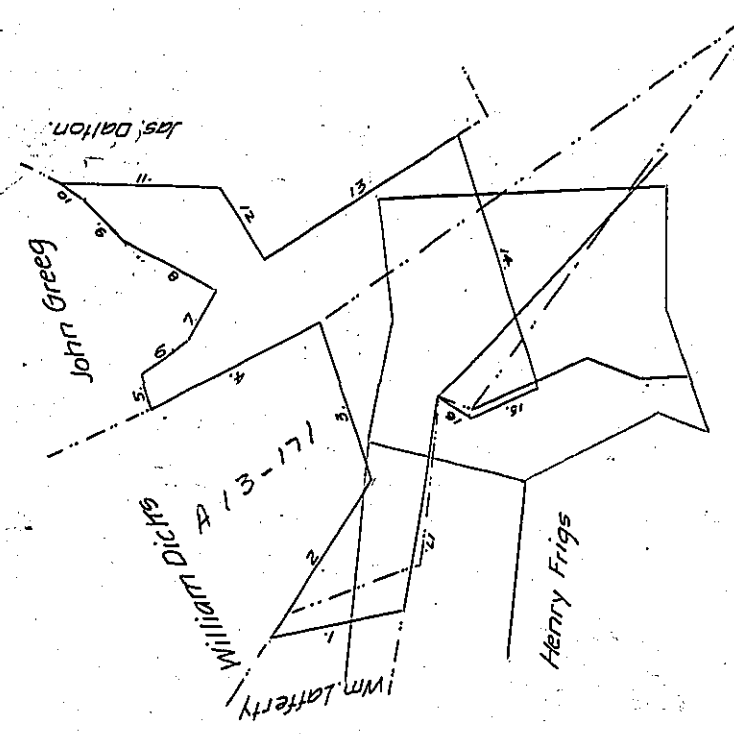

the one dotted and green lines represent part of a draft of a tract of land surveyed for James Taylor on warrant dated the 9th day of February 1813. This tract interferes eleven acres and one hundred and fifty nine perches with the Robert Thompson survey. James Taylor is the present owner.

The late coulered lines represent the draft of A tract of land surveyed for Daniel Ellis on Order No. 368 dated the 1st day of August, 1766, This tract interferes seventy nine acres and ninety two perches with the Robert Thompson Survey. Daniel Ellis conveyed to Levi Phillips the present Claimant

The other late coulered lines represent part of a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Joseph Reed on Order No. 369 dated the 1st day of August, 1766. This tract interferes twenty seven acres and one hundred and twenty nine perches with the Robert Thompson survey. Joseph Reed conveyed to Levi Phillips the present Claimant
