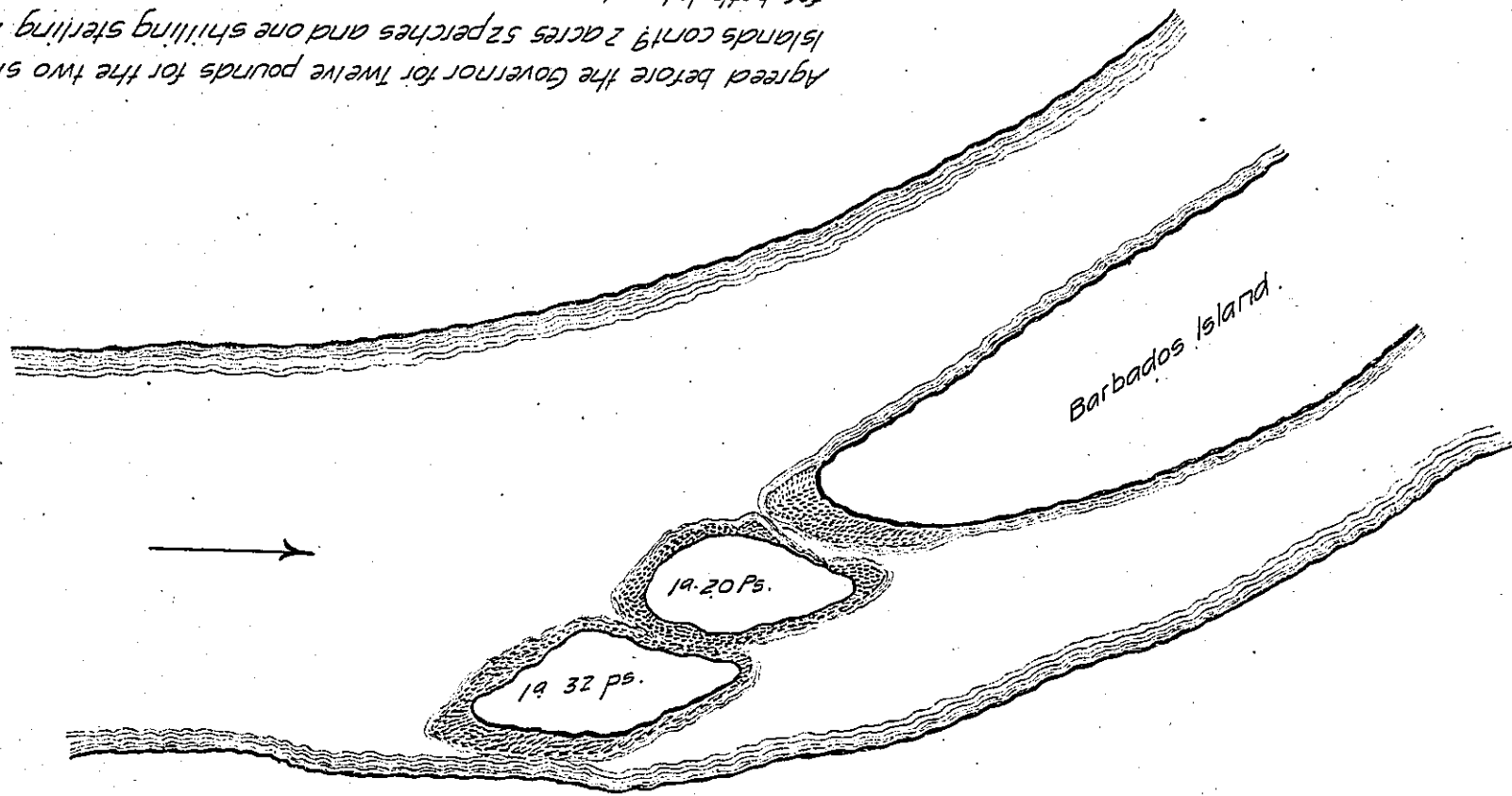


Agreed before the Governor for twelve pounds for the two small
