



Draft of a tract of land containing five acres and allowance of six per cent. situate in East Finley township of Washington County, Constructed from the returns of surveys on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, September 30, 1910, for Ida A. Plant's, J. Bayard Pollock, Thomas S. Crago and William D. Cotterrel the present applicants for a patent for the same. It being the remaining unpatented portion of a larger tract, Warranted to Abner Cloud and Ruth Hays, under date of November 1, 1786, and surveyed March 18, 1788. The other portion of the original tract being covered by Warrants and returns of surveys respectively in the names of Parker Campbell, John Smiley and Joseph Gorby, as shown on the above draft.
