



By virtue of a warrant from the Court at Kingess bearing date the 13th day of the 8th month 1680.

Laid out for John Mifflin sen^r & Jun^r a tract of land called Topps situated and being on the West side of Delaware River and on the east side of the Schoole kill. Beginning at a corner marked Hickery of the land of William Orins (called Edgerly Point) standing by the said Creek and from thence N. E. by E by Wth Orins line of marked trees 330 perches to a corner marked white oak, from thence S. E. by S by William Claytons line of marked trees 150 perches to a corner marked red oak standing near the said Claytons line and from thence S. W. by W. by a line of marked trees 312 perches to a corner marked black oak standing by the side of Schoolkil from thence by the said Creek 140 perches to the first mentioned Hickery containing 300 acres of land.

Surveyed the 23^d of the 3th mo. 1681.
