



Situate in Washington (late part of Warrington) Township York County, containing as above set forth ninety two acres & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 370<sup>58</sup> & allowance. Originally surveyed by John Forsythe Esq<sup>r</sup>, late D.S. in pursuance of two warrants, dated respectively the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1742 and 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1746 granted to Robert Corner. The above part resurveyed and divided off the said larger tract for Jacob Baker, at whose request the same is returned for confirmation, January 25, 1911, The whole tract being originally surveyed, March 20, 1770.
