



Situate in White Deer township, Union (late Berks) County surveyed the 29th day of July 1832 by virtue of an order granted to James Gally dated the 3d day of April 1769, No. 2640, containing one hundred & twenty six acres with the usual allowance of Six Per Cent &c. The same tract of land was surveyed the ___ day of ___ 1769 for James Gally. Note. Samuel Dale had a survey made the 18th day of March, 1793 by virtue of his warrant dated the 5th day of October, 1792, designated by the yellow lines which which interferes with James Gally about nineteen acres. Richard Irwin had a survey made the 2d day of August, 1792 in pursuance of his warrant dated the 28th day of October, 1788, designated by the green lines containing one hundred three acres with the usual allowance &c. which wholly interferes with James Gally. Peter Seidel and Henry Fisher had a survey made the ___ day of ___ 179___ in pursuance of their warrant dated the ___ day of ___ 179___ designated by the pink lines containing fifty acres with the usual allowance &c. which interferes with James Gally about nineteen acres. The survey in the name of Samuel Dale is now owned & occupied by John Lushbach in right of the said Samuel Dale. The survey in the name of Richard Irwin and the survey in the name of Peter Seidel and Henry Fisher are now owned & occupied by Dan Caldwell Esq. in right of the said Richard Irwin and the said Peter Seidel & Henry Fisher.
