The dotted lines represent part of a survey made for Gideon Miller on Warrant dated the 5th day of July, 1762. This survey interferes five acres and one hundred and ten perches with the Thomas Jones tract Gideon Miller conveyed to Jacob Hare who conveyed to Francis Reed who conveyed to Andrew Cate who conveyed to George Hanawalt who devised to George Hanawalt the present owner.
