Acres.

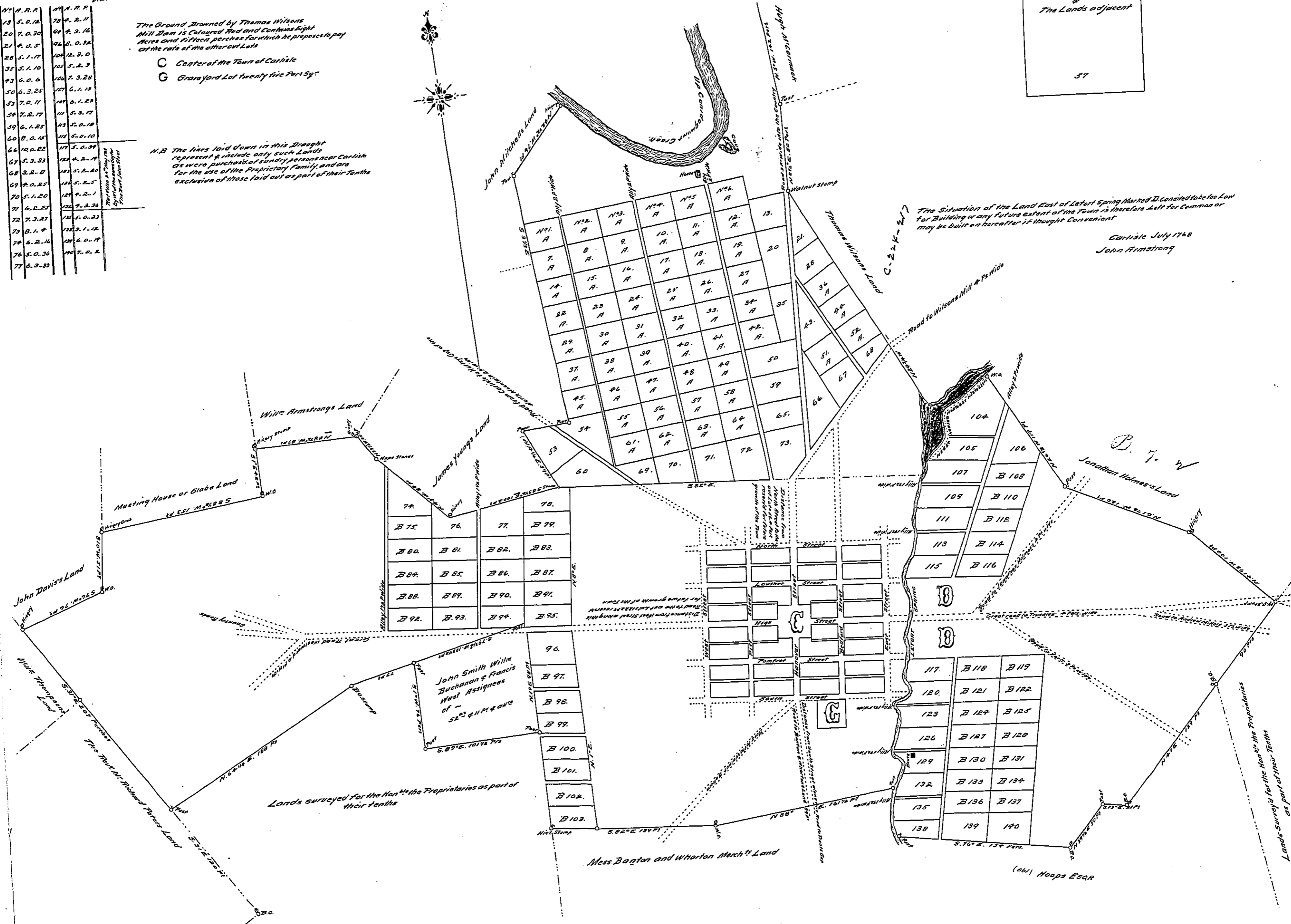
