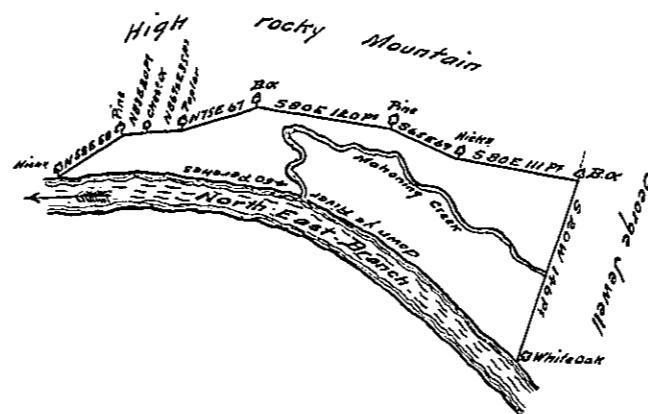

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 31st Day of January 1769 Surveyed 22^d Day of February 1769, unto the Honorable the Proprietaries the above described Tract of Land situate on Mehoning Creek, on the North Side the East Branch of Susquehanna, in the County of Berks, containing one hundred and eighty Acres & Allowance of Six PCent.
