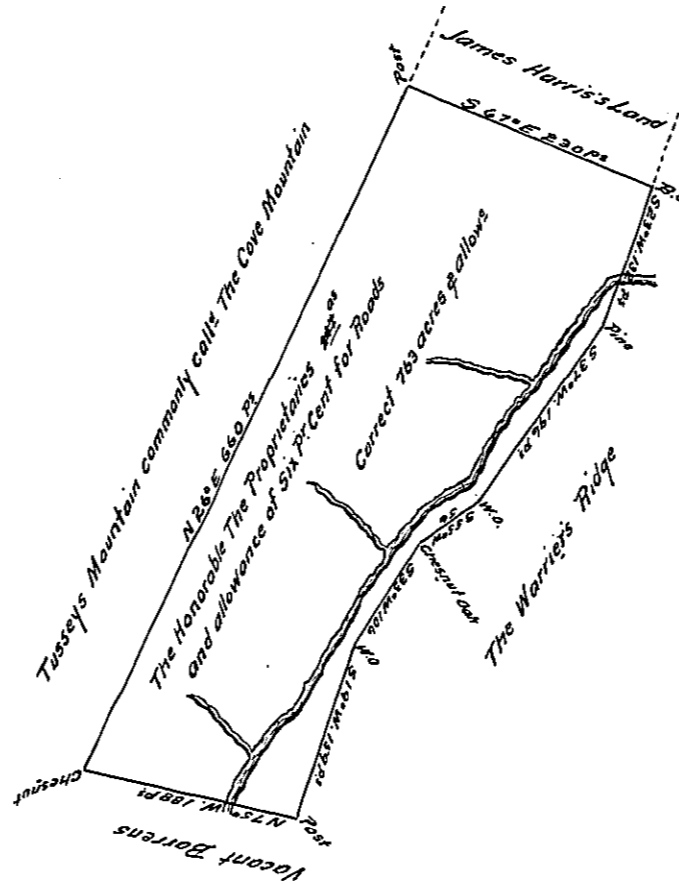

A Draught of a tract of land situate in the Warrier's Valley on the north west side of the Warrier's Ridge & on the south east side of Tussey's Mountain in Cumberland County containing ~~eight~~ seven hundred and eighty two sixty three acres and ~~three quarters and one~~ the usual allowance of six pr. cent for roads. Surveyed for the Honourable the Proprietaries August the 23rd 1762. In pursuance of the Honourable the Proprietaries Warrant bearing date the thirteenth day of October one thousand seven hundred & sixty 1760.
