



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of property bearing date the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland being numbered in the general Plan of said Town, Seventy three, and granted to William M. Cord containing in Length, East & West two hundred and thirty feet and in breadth North & South fifty seven feet Six inches bounded Westward by the Broad Way fronting the River Susquehanna, Northward by Barberry Alley, Eastward by River Alley & Southward by Lot No. 74 as by the General Plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear
