



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Malt store Situate on the Waters of Gravel run adjoining land Surveyed to Corns Conley & others on the Easterly side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna river (formerly in Berks but now) in Northumberland County containing Two hundred & Seventy one acres and 111 perches beside the usual allowance of 6 pcent for roads &c. Surveyed the 30th Day of September 1772 for Joseph Burr In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 15th Day of October 1771
