In Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the 28th of December 1772 granted to Elizabeth Buchanan Widow, In trust for her son Matthew Turner, at the request of Thos. Lightfoot I survey'd the above described small Parcel of Land marked B, called Turner's Outlet, containing 13 a & 30 p & allowance at the Rate of 6a per cent, adjoining another small Parcel lying on the Province Line described at F, which with other Land (Southward of the Line contiguous) was devised by Wm. Buchanan Deceased to his Step Son Matthew Turner aforesaid being part of a Tract formerly ^{granted} to Thomas Dixon by Warrant of the 2nd. of February 1737. Is Situate near Octororo Creek in West-Nottingham Township Chester Co. Survey'd 1st. Nov. 4th 1773 & Certify'd on Behalf of Thos. Lightfoot Dep. Surgt.
