



Situate on the old road leading from Bedford to Pittsburgh now in Jenner township Somerset County (late Cumberland Bedford County) the original 318 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre allowance Surveyed 18th September 1770 for Stewart Rowan Senr. in pursuance of an Order No. 406 dated 3rd April 1769 by Thomas Smith Esquire then Deputy Surveyor - The above 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre was Surveyed 20th May 1815 by John Wells Esqr. D.S. as appears by his official Draught remaining in my office & is now returned for a Patent to issue to Joseph Miller who will comply with the act of 22nd March 1820 by Executing a mortgage to the Govr. for the use of the Commonwealth - Certified 30th March 1824
