



By Virtue of Warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> proprietary dated the — Day of — Anno Dom<sup>ini</sup> 1735 There is Survey'd unto Aaron Price Two hundred acres with allowance of Six pcent in two Pieces one of which is an Island containing Twenty four acres and the other Begins at a Kicker by Susquehanna River Thence South Sixty pches South eighty west one hundred and Twenty four pches to chestnut Oak North Seventy <sup>five</sup> Degrees westerly Eighty Six pches to a white oak Thence north Sixty Eight degrees westerly sixty pches to a Post thence north Eighty degrees westerly Eighteen pches to a Post north Twenty degrees easterly Two hundred and Two pches to the sd River Then Traveling down the several courses of the sd River about Two hundred and Eighty pches to the place of Beginning.
