



The above draft represents a Tract of land situate in Sadsbury township Chester County containing ^{as} 6: 14 ^{ps.} and allowance of six per cent for roads &c being part of a Tract of ^{as} 178 & allowance which was surveyed on the 21st day of December 1781 unto William Armstrong on his Warrant dated the 31st day of January 1750: and which has been divided and laid off to John Armstrong son of the said William Armstrong, who is now deceased.
