In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1793, granted to David Ankeny for 150<sup>a</sup> as appears by his Official draught thereof remaining in my Office. And now the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March 1818 Certified and returned by me
