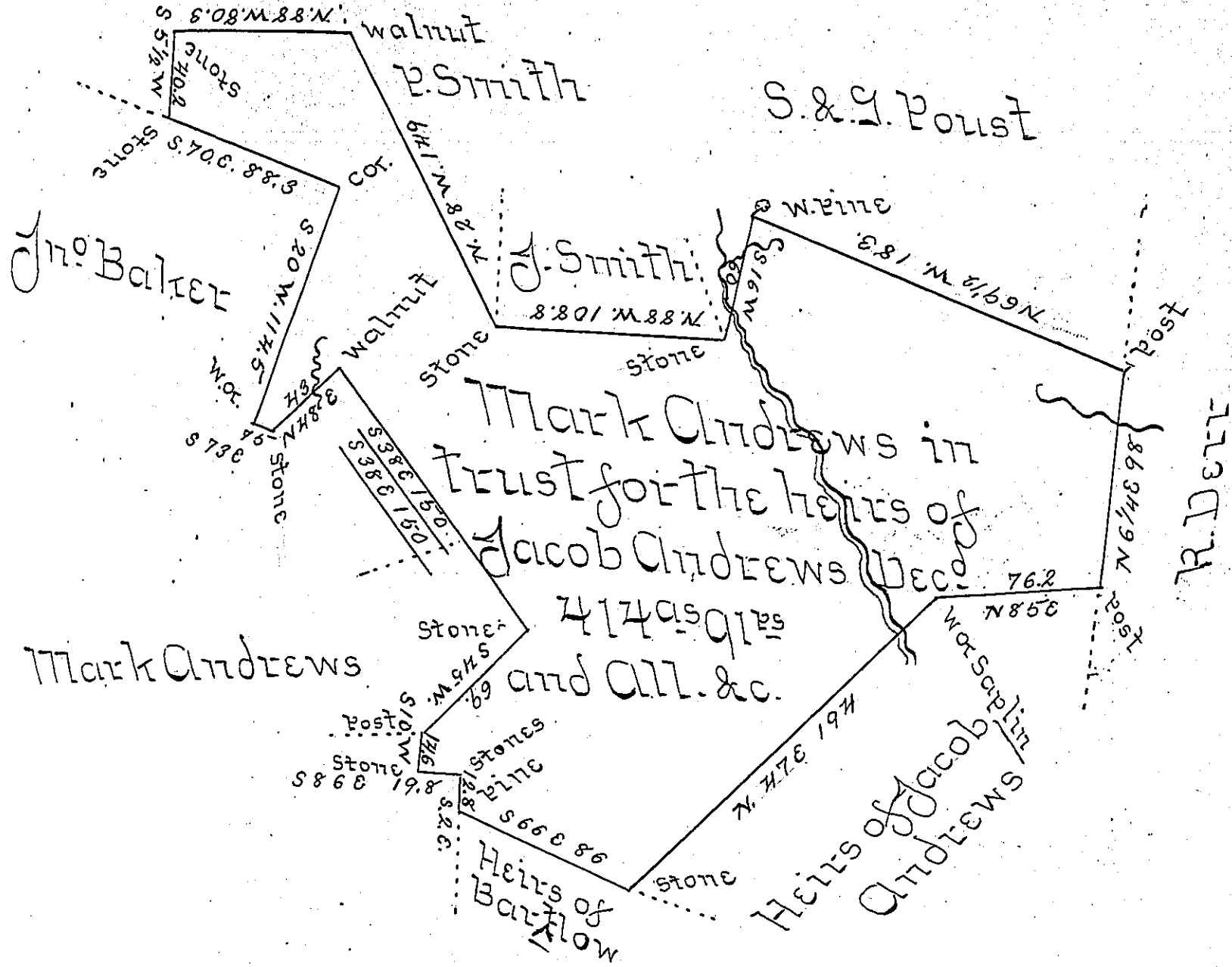


Albert Hughes



Surveyed the 14th day of May 1851 to Mark Andrews in trust for the heirs of Jacob Andrews Decd in virtue of his warrant bearing date the 21st April 1851 containing four hundred, fourteen acres, and ninety one perches with the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Situate in Moreland Township Lycoming County.
