



Surveyed the above described piece of land for William Ambrose the first day of December 1843 containing Ten acres and one hundred and twenty four perches and the usual allowance of six per cent &c. and whereas since to wit on the 3^d day of January 1844 a Warrant was granted for the same unto the said Ambrose and in pursuance of said Warrant I return the survey as heretofore by me ^{on same} made situate in Wigonier Township and in the County of Westmoreland
