



The above out lines represents a survey made in the year A.D. 1815 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Alexander dated the 20th day of Feb. 1815 situate in South Beaver Township Beaver County as appears from the entry in the Survey Book containing 405 ac 45 perches, the inside black lines represents a purchase made by John Martin Esqr containing 125 ac 68 perches & the usual allowance agree-
 able to the courses & distances described above.
