



"Situate in Franklin township Fayette County and Resurveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1822 In pursuance of a Warrant dated the thirtieth day of August 1785 and as well to reduce it to reasonable bounds the original Survey having embraced his whole claim as represented by the dotted lines. He, the original being dead, the heirs have divided the whole tract as represented. Note there is on the premises a hewed log house a kitchen, Double barn, other lesser buildings, about 40 Fruit trees & about 40 acres cleared in a good state of Cultivation.
