



A Draught of one hundred eighty five acres forty two perches of land, and the usual alleys of six P Cent for roads &c. Situate in Wayne Township (formerly Cumberland) now Mifflin County part of a tract of land surveyed in August - for John Armstrong Esqr, in pursuance of his warrant dated the 1st day of June 1762 granted unto him for 200^{ac}. Returned into the Secretaries Office 26th Sept 1766 & signed John Lukens S. G. Divided as above laid down 11th Feb 1804 for Wm Robison & James Huston & Wm Harris D.S. Returned 1826 for James Robison the present owner from the notes of Wm Harris late D.S. &c &c
