



The Draught of a Tract of Land called *Maghara* situate in *Kishacoquillis Valley Cumberland County* containing One Hundred Seventy Nine acres 153 Perches with the usual allowance of six acres P. Ct. for Roads surveyed the 9th day of June 1766 (agreeable to the lines of a former Survey made by John Armstrong Esq.)
