



A Draught of survey made April 27th 1827 in pursuance of a Warrant granted Isaac Adams bearing date the 7th of December 1826 containing 360 Acres and 12 perches and the usual allowance of 6 percent for Roads &c situate Centre Township in the County of Greene

To Gabriel Heister Esqr S. G. John Fordyce D. S.

N. B. There are three actual residents settlements on the above survey one of them appears to have been made more than twenty years ago. I know that George Heighenbothem did once claim the land to the dotted line that is 17 perches within the above survey. But Isaac Adams has the land in possession and I am not certain that Heighenbothem intends to prosecute his claim but I think that there is a probability of it. I give the quantity of Acres claimed by Heighenbothem and course and distance from Adams R.O to Heighenbothems W.O and again from Adams post to H. Hickory that would the land fall to Heighenbothem Adams may obtain his Patent for 334 A & 35 ps without a resurvey.
