



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 25<sup>th</sup> June 1773 the above described Tract of land was surveyed to Thomas Almore on the 26<sup>th</sup> of July 1786 by Jos. J. Wallis late Deputy Surv<sup>r</sup>. Situate on the south side of Towandane Creek: including part of the Goosberry Run in the County of Luzerne; containing 308<sup>as</sup> 80 perches and allowance of six P. Cent for Roads &c.
