Being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed on the 8th day of February 1755 by George Stevenson late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 4th day of April 1754 granted to Thomas Armor. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 18th of 7th Mo.

1794 by William Kersey late D.S. And now, after having been carefully examined, corrected and calculated, it is, at the request of the present owner, Peter Mengus, returned for confirmation the 29th day of July A.D. 1809.
