By examining the Drafts of Surveys made by Benj<sup>d</sup> Lodge it appears that 115 1/2 Acres of the above described Tract of Land was on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June 1789 Surveyd to Leonard Albright on the Warr<sup>t</sup> in the name of John Miller, Jun<sup>r</sup> dated January 17<sup>th</sup> 1770 but I find no such Warrant among B. Lodges papers therefore the Surveyor General will accept or reject this Draught as he thinks proper
