



Draught of ninety nine acres and 109 perches and the allowance of Six Pr. Cent for roads &c. Part of a larger tract of land situate in Fermanagh Township formerly Cumberland now Mifflin County. Resurveyed the 15th of Nov^r. 1768. Said to contain 256⁶/₁₀ acres and the allowance &c. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Armstrong dated the 3^d day of February 1755. Divided the 31st day of January 1806 and the above part laid off agreeable to a line said to have been formerly made for Andrew Bogle
