We the Commissioners, for adjusting the claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio Do hereby certifie that John Minter is intitled to four hundred Acres of Land in Yohogania County on the waters of Yohogania River to include his Improvement made thereon in the year 1769 Also a right in Preemption to one thousand Acres adjoining thereto — Given under our hands at Cox's fort the 9<sup>th</sup> day Feb<sup>y</sup> 1780 and in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
