



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission to me directed under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philad^a the 14th of August 1783 the above tract of land Containing two hundred and one Acres ~~xx~~ and allowance of Six Per Cent for roads &c^a was surveyed on the 4th day of June 1785 by
