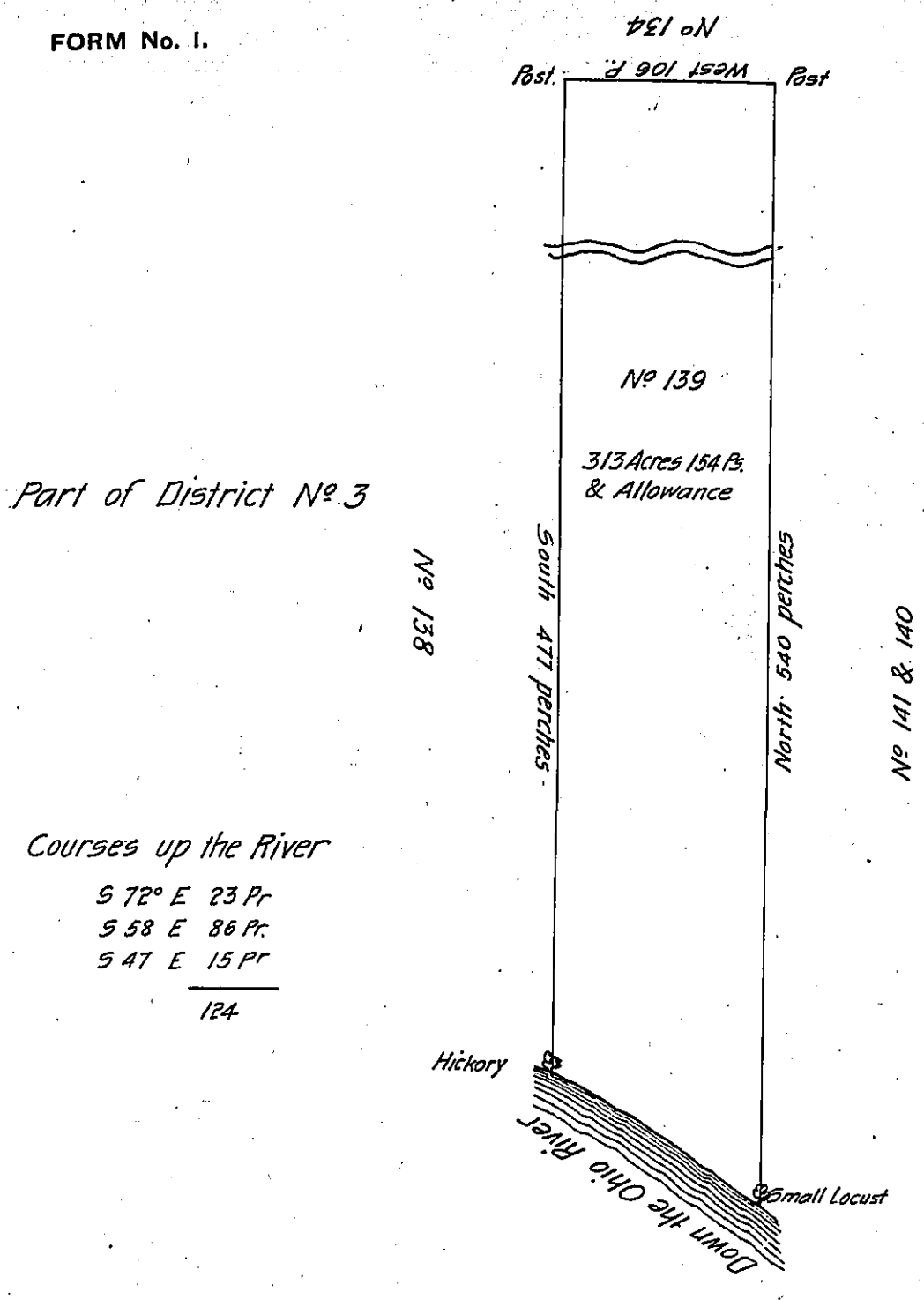

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of certain land therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philad^a the 14th day of August 1783 the above tract of land Containing three hundred and thirteen Acres and one hundred and fifty four perches & allowance of Six Per cent for roads &c. was surveyed on the 28th day of July 1785 by
