In pursuance of the Application N^o 2829 for 100^a dated the 20th day of February 1767 Granted to William Sinclair who sold the same to Samuel Harper. And now on the 27th day of August Anno Domini 1805 at the request of the Present Owner, Andrew Anderson, we are desired to make return of the Draught & as calculated, examined and corrected find it to contain Seventy four Acres & Sixty three Perches & the usual allowance of Six Acres Per Cent &c.
