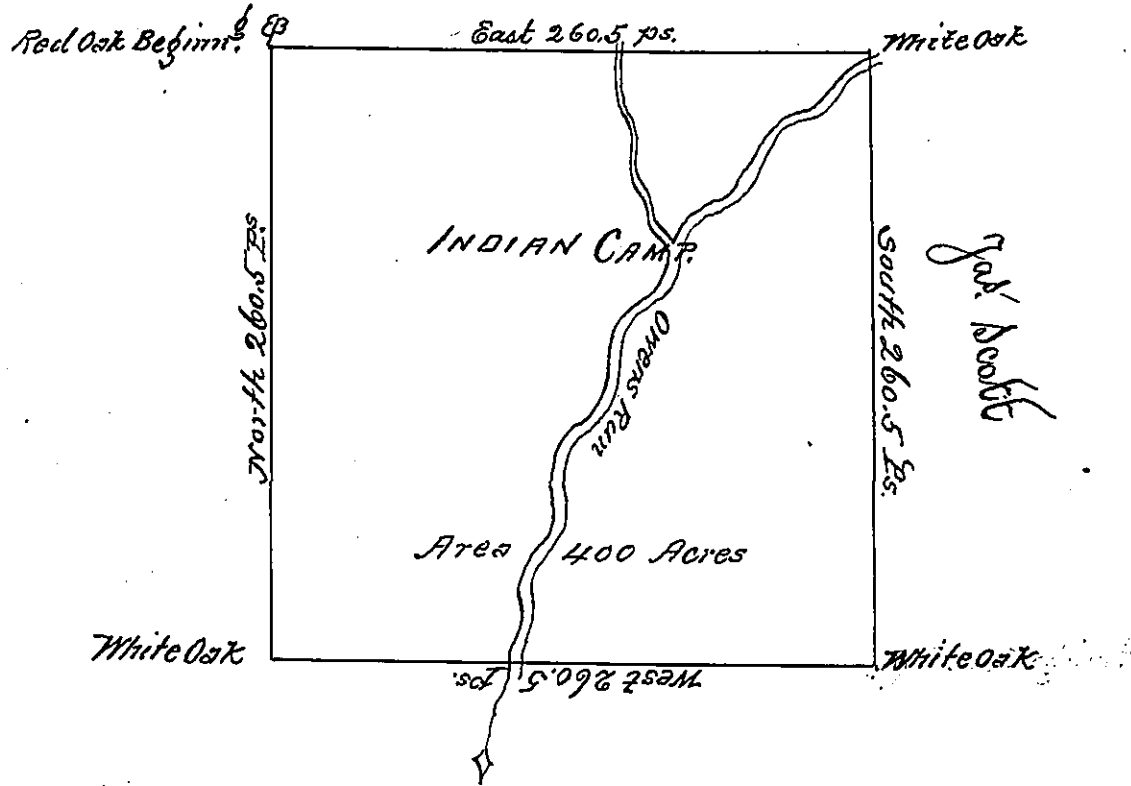


Robert Smith
