



Situate on Crosses Mill Run, a Branch of Dandy Creek in Wharton Township, Fayette County, & surveyed the 15th day of September 1835. In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Benjamin Rose, for 400^{ac} dated the 5th day of February 1794. the only improvement on this tract, is a part of the Mill race connected with the mill on the Charles Rose tract which adjoins this survey.
