



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 24th day of January 1733 Survey'd unto George Bostock a Tract of Land in Goshen Barrens in Chester County Beginning at a post in a Line of Elizabeth Eachey's Land then N. N. W. by ye same 160 pches to a post thence W. S. West 106 pches to a Hickory thence S. S. East 160 pches to a Black Oak thence E. N. E 106 pches to the place of Beginning containing one Hundred acres & the usual allowance for Road
