



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July following for George Fulmer on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and forty nine Containing in Breadth East and West on Dewberry Street Sixty feet and in length North and South on River Street Two hundred and Thirty feet Bounded Northward by Dewberry Street, Eastward by River Street, Southward by Mulberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and fifty - Returned into the Secretary's office the 13th day of June 1774 for Philip Bobbenmeyer by Warrant dated the 10th day of June 1774
