



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the twentieth day of September 1762 granted to the late Henry Bouquet Esqr. I have Surveyed on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1767 the above described Tract of Land situate on the waters of Trough Creek Valley in the County of Cumberland, called the Two ~~Butt~~ Springs, containing Two Hundred and twenty nine acres and the usual allowance of six acres p<sup>l</sup> M. for Roads &c. (The right whereof is now vested in Thomas Willing Esqr.)
