



In pursuance of a Warrant granted to the late Henry Boquet Esqr. dated the twentieth day of September 1762, Surveyed the twenty sixth day of August 1767 the above described Tract of Land situate on the Waters of Trough Creek in Trough Creek Valley in the County of Cumberland called the Fine Meadows containing Two Hundred and twenty nine acres and the usual allowance of six Acres  $\frac{1}{2}$  for Roads &c. (The Right whereof is now vested in Thomas Willing Esqr.)
